Admission to Certificate Training Course in ‘The Fundamentals in Abdomino Pelvic Ultrasonography: Level one for MBBS Doctors’ under The PC- PNDT (Prohibition of Sex Selection) (Six months training) Rules, 2014, at Goa Medical College & Hospital, Bambolim-Goa.

1. **Application form** for the above training course will be available on the official website and at the office of State Family Welfare Bureau, Directorate of Health Services, Campal, Panaji - Goa from 27th July – 31st July 2026, from 9:30 am to 4:30 pm.

3. **Eligibility Criteria:**

Any Registered Medical Practitioner (MBBS) registered with the Goa Medical Council.

4. **Course Duration:** The period of training course shall be 6 months. The course is scheduled over a period of six months i.e. September 2026 to February 2027.

The date of entrance examination for general candidates will be in the Third week of August 2026. The final date will be telephonically informed to the registered applicants and will also be displayed on the notice board of State family Welfare Bureau, DHS, Campal – Panaji Goa. The In -service candidates are exempted from entrance test.

5. The complete application form of General and In-service candidates along with all enclosures (Mail or by post) should reach the office of State Family Welfare Bureau, Directorate of Health Services, Campal, Panaji-Goa, on or before 7th August 2026 by 4:30 pm. The candidates are instructed to see the website periodically from the date of applying.
